

Oregon City Faith-Based Scavenger Hunt

Stop 1: End of the Oregon Trail

Address: 1726 Washington St, Oregon City, OR

Clue: Before highways and engines, wagons ended their journey here.

- Find the outdoor marker or signage
- Photo: Pretend to push a wagon
- Reflection: Psalm 121:8 – Share what helps you trust God
- Trivia: Oregon City was once the largest city west of the Rockies (True)

Stop 2: McLoughlin Promenade

Address: Entrance near 10th & High St, Oregon City, OR

Clue: A peaceful path above the river where stillness meets history.

- Walk the promenade and sit quietly
- Reflection: Psalm 46:10 – 60 seconds of stillness
- Trivia: John McLoughlin was a fur trader, physician, and 'Father of Oregon'

Stop 3: Willamette Falls Viewpoint

Address: Main St overlook areas, Oregon City, OR

Clue: Hear the roar of waters that powered a city.

- Take a photo or short video
- Reflection: Psalm 42:7 – Where do you need strength?
- Trivia: One of the largest waterfalls by volume in the U.S.

Stop 4: Downtown Main Street

Address: Main St, Oregon City, OR

Clue: Where locals gather, shop, and share daily life.

- Walk one full block
- Do a small act of kindness
- Reflection: Mark 12:31 – Love your neighbor
- Trivia: Early growth came from lumber & milling

Stop 5: Municipal Elevator

Address: 6 Railroad Ave, Oregon City, OR

Clue: Rise without stairs and see the city below.

- Ride the elevator and take a photo
- Reflection: 1 Peter 5:6 – Humility lifts us
- Trivia: Only outdoor municipal elevator in the U.S.

Stop 6: Coffee or Rest Stop (Optional)

Address: Any local café downtown, Oregon City, OR

Clue: Rest your feet and refresh your spirit.

- Rest and reflect
- Reflection: Matthew 11:28 – Name one gratitude
- Trivia: First incorporated city west of the Rockies

Stop 7: Clackamette Park

Address: 1900 Clackamette Dr, Oregon City, OR

Clue: Where two rivers meet and journeys pause.

- Walk to the river meeting point
- Closing prayer or reflection
- Trivia: Willamette Falls is about 40 feet tall
